

7:00 am	Turn off Bilbo AC Turn on hallway fan for air movement in chameleon room Dogs feeder goes off - let dogs out to bathroom Refill fog machines (all three) Mist marked plants in house (8)
7:30 am	Mist all chameleon enclosures - 1 minute, avoid direct spray on temp sensors Close vent in laundry room (running against pipe) Close vent in cham room Hamster enclosure spot clean from poop & pee spots Feed hamster 1 TBS food - scatter around enclosure
8:00 am	UVB & plant lights on - chameleons - gecko Turn off hallway fan
	Feed - Bilbo - 20 BSFL in bird cup & 20 crickets w/ calcium in feeder run Feed - Tree & Kitty on Monday, Wednesday, Friday - feeders each w/ calcium Feed bugs - Monday, Wednesday, Friday - pick out old food, replace with fresh food
8:15 am	Basking lights turn on (start to monitor temps in enclosures, hourly checks to ensure they don't get too hot)
3:00 am	Dripper installed on chameleon enclosures, place where they drip over a leaf that chameleon can easily reach, let me know if you see them drinking or rush to the water - remove cups when water is gone
8:00 pm	UVB & plant lights off - chameleons - gecko Open vent in laundry room (running with pipe) Open vent in cham room Gecko fresh food & water
8:15	Gecko UVB on for 15 minutes
8:30	Gecko UVB off - mist enclosure - plants & walls, avoid sensors,
9:30 pm	Mist chameleon enclosures - avoid direct spray with sensors Turn on Bilbo AC unit Ensure that temps are 68 degrees or lower before allowing fog machines to go off - if the enclosure is too warm just unplug the fog machine for the night.
Friday	Refill dog food Wash & refill dog's water Wash & refill hamsters water

**\*Daily - monitor enclosures for poop and clean up immediately if found - to avoid spreading parasites only pick up poop AFTER feeding all reptiles and WASH HANDS after each enclosure poop is cleaned up. If you see orange, red or yellow in the urate (white part/ chameleon pee) please let me know right away and send pics**
